| 1 | The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 03 (one sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 20 of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 32 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension. |
| 2 | The school is not running bal-vatika presently. Thus, it is required to submit an undertaking that from upcoming session school will run bal-vatika within 03 months in the compliance. |
| 3 | The physics lab has washbasins, which is not required. In the biology lab, school is using chairs in place of wooden stools. Further, both the said labs have few make-shift tables, which is not appropriate. Further, the chemistry lab has plastics stools in place of wooden stools. Thus, the school is required to upgrade the said labs in light of Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance. |

| 4 | The composite science lab is under stocked, it does not have gas connection and few make-shift tables have been arranged as workstations. Also, there are chairs being used for seating in place of wooden stools. Thus, the school is required to upgrade the same in light of Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance. |
| 5 | The mathematics lab is under stocked and temporarily set-up on make shift tables. It does not have sufficient seating arrangement for students. Further, there is a globe, few maps and other equipment also seen, hence, it is appearing that it is run combined with Sst lab, which is not appropriate. Thus, the school is required to set-up the mathematics lab separately as per Board's SoP for lab within 03 months and submit the compliance. |
| 6 | The library is under stocked. Thus, the school is required to procure more books within 03 months and submit the compliance. |
| 7 | The school is required to appoint more TGT and PGT from class IX onward as per teacher section ratio 1:1.5 within 03 months and submit the appointment letter with education qualification and revised list of staff member in the compliance. |
| 8 | The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Prayagraj within 03 months and submit the compliance. |
| 9 | The school shall ensure that the staff salary is paid on time as per norms of the state |

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
